Club Championship Policy

For the purpose of determining which teams will represent SCC at Curling Ontario Club Championship qualifier tournaments, the following process will be used:

1. **April Qualifier:**
The highest-ranked eligible men's team and women's team, based on standings at the conclusion of the second (2nd) draw of the Open Competitive League, will be offered the opportunity to represent SCC. Teams will be advised of their standing within one week of the conclusion of the second (2nd) draw. April qualifying teams can defer to play in the October qualifiers.
2. **October Qualifier:**
The highest-ranked eligible men's team and women's team, based on final standings at the conclusion of league playoffs, will be offered the opportunity. Teams will be advised of their standing within one week of the conclusion of the playoffs via email.
3. **Duplicate Qualification:**
If the same team qualifies for both the April and October events, the October position will be offered to the next highest-ranked eligible team, in accordance with Curling Ontario rules limiting teams to one qualifier per season.
4. **Declination:**
If a team declines to participate, the opportunity will be offered to the next highest-ranked eligible team. If a team does not respond within 14 days of being notified of their opportunity, it will be deemed void and offered to the next highest-ranked eligible team.
5. **Eligibility:**
All players must meet Curling Ontario eligibility requirements. Team composition must comply with Curling Ontario requirements and definitions. An eligible team is a team whose players meet Curling Ontario eligibility requirements and have participated in the SCC Open Competitive League. The SCC will allow for one spare to be added to the team roster. This player must meet Curling Ontario requirements.
6. **Ranking Method:**
Rankings will be determined based on the Open Competitive League scoring system, with ties broken by the head to head record over the

course of the season for the qualifying period. If a tie still exists, the winner will be determined by random draw.

7. Disputes:

Any disputes regarding interpretation of this policy will be resolved by the Draw Chair and Open Competitive League Convener, whose decision shall be final.

8. Policy Review:

This policy will be reviewed annually and may be adjusted to remain consistent with Curling Ontario requirements and scheduling.
